

2020 Greater Huntsville Panhellenic Association Scholarship Guidelines

The Greater Huntsville Panhellenic Association offers a merit based scholarship payable in 2020 to a young lady who attended Greek Meet 2019 or submitted a recruitment packet in 2019, has been initiated into a National Panhellenic sorority and is a current full-time student. This scholarship is non-recurring and will be payable to winners directly. This scholarship is based on academic records, sorority involvement, volunteer activities, and an essay.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. The applicant must be a full time student attending accredited institutions of secondary education to include associate, baccalaureate or a master's degree.
2. Applicants must have attended the 2019 Huntsville Panhellenic Association's Greek Meet or submitted a recruitment packet to the Greater Huntsville Panhellenic Association in 2019
3. Applicants must have been initiated into a National Panhellenic Association sorority during the 2019-2020 school year.
4. **All materials must be submitted together and postmarked no later than January 20, 2020. DO NOT** mail application Registered Mail or any other method that requires a signature as all mail arrives at a PO Box. **Requiring a signature for delivery may delay your application or cause it to be returned to sender by the Post Office.**
5. This scholarship is a merit based scholarship; therefore, financial need will not be a consideration in the selection of the recipient.
6. Recipients may retain the Huntsville Panhellenic Scholarship regardless of other scholarships received.

PROCEDURE:

1. The application packet **must include:**
 - a. College transcript (copy is fine if name of school is included)
 - b. Completed DATA sheet
 - c. Completed APPLICATION
 - d. Essay
 - e. Original copies of two (2) letters of recommendations.

FAILURE TO MEET THE JANUARY 20th DEADLINE OR COMPLETE ANY OF THE REQUIREMENTS STATED ABOVE WILL RESULT IN AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION.

2. All properly submitted applications will be reviewed and evaluated by the Panhellenic Scholarship Committee in accordance with the guidelines. All information on the application will be treated in a confidential manner.
3. Scholarship money will be sent directly to the recipient's institution of higher learning. Scholarship money may be used for tuition and/or college educational expenses.
4. Scholarships will be awarded in time for the fall semester of the 2020-2021 academic year. Once scholarship has been awarded it will be up to the student and institution to apply the scholarship to tuition or other educational expenses
5. Scholarship winner(s) will be notified by mail of the outcome of the scholarship awards.
